Your teacher will have sent details of dates and times for next week. Please note Year 6 evenings are Nov 28 and Dec 1st.

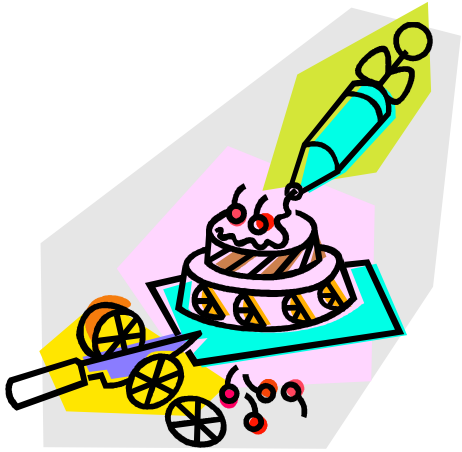
Please help us improve attendance and lateness

CHILDREN IN NEED 2011

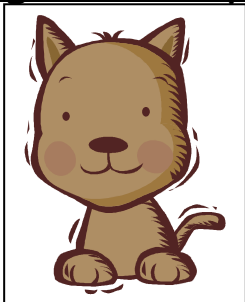
