Dear Parents,

We hope you have had a lovely half term. We are always happy to support you and your children over the year and we will be in our usual drop off and collection points before school and after school if you have any messages or questions. Library and PE days.

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
Curriculum Autumn 2: The History of the £10 Note

History

We are studying the history of the £10 note. We will be looking and past significant figures who have been lucky enough to be on the £10 note, researching significant sports figures and who would we put onto a £10 note today.

English

We will be reading a text called 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell focussing on reading skills including inference, retrieval and learning new vocabulary. We will be exploring the story and to use it to write our own narrative with dialogue and we will write a non-chronological report inventing our own animal.



Maths

This half term we will have a real focus on fractions, decimals and percentages.

RE

In our religious studies we will be looking at incarnation. Children will learn about Christian views of Jesus as the Messiah and study the evidence presented in the bible.

Science	We will be learning about Light. To learn this, children will use a range of investigative skills.
Music	In our music sessions we will be learning about themes and variation.
French	In our weekly French lessons we will be learning to describe the French home.
PDL	In our Jigsaw lessons we will look at celebrating difference which includes looking at differences between people, power struggles and bullying.
Computing	Children will be learning creating media
Art	In our art, we will explore pop art and look at Andy Warhol.
