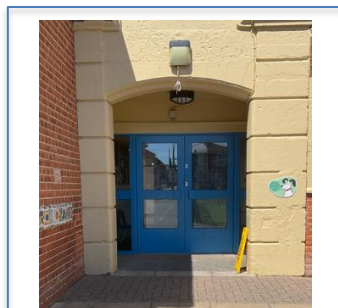
In Year 2, children will continue to develop independence and focused learning time will increase from Year 1 with more independent tasks. English will include a focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar. Children will learn how to write for different purposes and in different forms, including poetry and non-fiction writing. Maths will develop multiplication skills and simple fractions. Pupils will study weights and measures and look at the properties of shapes. Science work will involve learning how to conduct experiments and record observations. They will learn about their environment, living things and properties and uses of materials.
